OUR SERVICES

DAILY MEALS:

Our daily community meal is 5pm-6pm and open to everyone. We serve about 1,000 meals daily to hungry men, women and children in our community, program residents, & emergency shelter guests.

EMERGENCY OVERNIGHT SHELTERS:

Beds are first-come, first-served. We have housing for individuals, single mothers, families, & we are the only local shelter able to accommodate single fathers.

RESIDENT RECOVERY PROGRAM:

A free one-year program for men & women with life-controlling addictions who *want* to make a positive life change. Residents have all physical needs met during the program to focus on recovery.

ADDITIONAL SERVICES

FOOD PANTRY PROGRAM:

Provides food for families in need.

HOLIDAY FOOD BASKETS:

Distributed in November & December.

MOTHERS WITH BABIES:

Provides formula, baby food, diapers, etc.

ESSENTIAL GIVEAWAY PROGRAM:

Free clothing & essentials to assist those in need from head to toe, such as shoes, eyeglasses, hygiene kits, etc. Giveaways are Tuesdays & Thursdays 9am-Noon.

SPIRITUAL GUIDANCE:

One of our primary goals is to touch lives with the love of Jesus Christ. LVRM has a full-time resident pastor on staff. Daily Bible study classes & sessions are facilitated by caring staff & volunteers.
