## Moving Families from Homeless to a Home

In Las Vegas, there are roughly 6,490 individuals and families without homes or a steady shelter at night, including 2,052 children. Affordable housing and jobs continue to be the leading roadblocks to a family having a home. To address this growing problem, local agencies have joined forces to help families transition from homelessness to stability and independence through compassionate guidance, shelter, and education. By combining efforts, we can provide more services to families in need, and increase success in ending homelessness one family at a time faster! Since this collaboration began in February, 92 families, or 278 men, women and children now have a better tomorrow!



# My Journey From Chaos to Cook

I grew up in Las Vegas in a family where it was normal to use drugs and alcohol as a family. By age 12, I was drinking, using cocaine and acid, and by age 14 or 15, I was a full-blown addict. Going to church with my Mom was part of my childhood, but as drugs took over my life, I quit going. I also dropped out of high school and became detached from everyone and everything. As I felt more isolated, lonely and frustrated, I knew I needed to change, but I didn't know where to start.

"When my Mom died of breast cancer at age 47, I asked God why He took her and let me live?"

I was at rock bottom when I heard God's voice encouraging me to look at my life. I knew God would forgive me, and through that forgiveness, I could change and get my dignity back. I quit drugs and alcohol one week prior to coming to the Las Vegas Rescue Mission to prove I was serious about making a change.

I joined the Resident Recovery program in April 2015 and graduated in October 2016. Cooking is a passion of mine, and I'm now a cook at the Mission. Now at the age of 47, the same age as my Mom at her death, I have my life back and looking forward to seeing what God has next

to seeing what God has next in store for me.
