Wen's battle with addiction began when he was just a young teenager. As it took over, he began stealing from friends and family.

"I was burning bridges left and right," he says. "I broke into friends' houses. I stole from my mom. It didn't matter who you were — I would burn a bridge to get a high in a heartbeat and not even worry about the repercussions."

It wasn't long before he wound up homeless, living on the streets of Las Vegas. Sometimes, he even slept out in the desert. Fortunately, he found the Las Vegas Rescue Mission, and thanks to friends like you, he found the support he needed to finally make a change in his life.

When Boston first moved to Las Vegas about 26 years ago, things were going well. But when he lost his job, he got sucked into a side of Las Vegas he had never seen before.

For the next few years, his life was a cycle of drugs and prison. Eventually, Boston decided he needed to make a real change in his life. "I was basically sick and tired of being sick and tired," he says. "I got tired of going to prison and just not being an upright individual in society."
